Mac OS 10.x and Plantronics Bluetooth Headset

The following is a screen shot of the System Preferences on the Mac that can be accessed through the apple icon in the upper left of the screen.



The open window shows the System Preferences, select Bluetooth in the Hardware option and it will open the Bluetooth Setup Assistant.




Select the Headset option and press Continue.



Once the Bluetooth Setup Assistant finds the required Plantronics Headset press Continue.


A passkey is needed to complete the pairing between the computer and the headset; the passkey will be **0000** for all Plantronics Bluetooth Headsets.



The installation procedure concludes with the following screen shot.




You will have to direct the Input and Output sound to the Bluetooth Headset, in the System Preferences under the Sound option.



The Input panel shows the devices that may be selected for input, select the required Plantronics Bluetooth Headset. Be aware of the Input level and input volume control.

The microphone will show activity in the input level indicator. This is the easiest way to see if the microphone in the Plantronics Bluetooth Headset is working.



In the Output panel, the Plantronics Bluetooth Headset MUST be selected in order to operate. Clicking on the headset will highlight it, showing that it has been selected. Notice the Balance control.
